The Faith and Obedience of Abraham (Genesis 17:15-27) In Genesis 17, God swears and confirms his covenantal faithfulness to Abraham, insisting that he would be God to Abraham and to Abraham's offspring after him, and sealing that promise with the sign of circumcision.

Abraham offered up his one and only son in obedience to God's command. John 3:16 tells us: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son (the exact same word in the Greek), that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16) Jesus and Isaac were both obedient sons to their fathers, even unto death.

The exemplary value of Abraham's faith is made up of three key features: obedience, trust, and fidelity. The obedience of faith Abraham declares his faith principally by obeying God.
