Now just speckle the area of your paper you just put water on.

Rinse and load brush with blue paint and dab a blue circle near both the red and the yellow circles... forming a triangle.... observe how the spreading paint forms new colors. 8. "Next place a loaded brush of color on the paper and draw it toward you forming a straight line. Add another line next to it with another color.
