Students will use computational and graphing skills to search for patterns in the movements of the islands and seamounts. They will then construct a best fit line graph to calculate the plate's speed.

The result is a trail of volcanoes with one end of the line located over the hot spot and quite active and the other end distant and inactive. In between is a succession of volcanoes that are progressively older with distance from the hot spot. A Figure 2.13 shows the distribution of the Hawaiian Islands Chain and Emperor Seamount Chain.
