Deadly nightshade (*Atropa belladonna*) belongs to the same family of tomato and potato. Being one of the most poisonous plants, all parts of the plant particularly root and fruits are toxic. The major poisonous substances present in the plant are atropine, scopolamine and hyoscyamine. They harm the nervous system.

RHUBARB, Rheum, leaves and leaf blade are fatal! ROSARY BEAN, (Jequirity Bean, Crab's Eye, Precatroy Bean), Abrus, seeds commonly called "beans" are fatal! ROSEMARY, leaves of certain varieties are harmless, others are poisonous. RUSSIAN THISTLE, *Carduus* or *Silybum*, foliage and flowering part.

Many spring bulbs, including hyacinths and daffodils forced for indoor blooms, are toxic if eaten by humans or pets. Eating the bulbs (which can be mistaken for shallots or onions) can cause intense stomach problems, high blood pressure, irregular heartbeat, and even death.

Poison ivy (*Toxicodendron radicans*) and its close relatives poison sumac (*T. vernix*) and poison oak (*T. diversilobum*) all contain a chemical known as urushiol.
