Minimum Admission Requirements All applicants must hold a Bachelor of Science degree, typically in engineering, physical sciences, mathematics, from an accredited institution. Students who do not already hold a degree in engineering may be considered for provisional admission if the technical division minimum prerequisites are successfully completed.

While final admission decisions are made by the Graduate School, the Department of Mechanical Engineering faculty review all completed applications. Applicants are notified of the Graduate School's final decision on a rolling basis through their online application portal.
